

USMRA Procedures for DMOB Nominations

Distinguished Member of the Airborne and Ranger Training Brigade

Through 5th Ranger Training Battalion, USMRA may submit nominees to ARTB for consideration. 5th Ranger Training Battalion may make two nominations each year. In the past, it has been an honor for USMRA to receive one or both nominations. Complete evaluation criteria are announced by ARTB.

Any USMRA member may nominate another who has served in the ARTB for this honor. Nominations are due to USMRA by 3 October and must be submitted to Brian Cunningham at brianc2327@me.com.

The minimum information required in each packet is as follows:

- Letter of nomination describing in detail why the nominee should be considered.
- A biographical outline of the nominee's military service and service to their community. Include dates of service in the ARTB.
- An 8 x 10 photo suitable for posting at ARTB headquarters.
- A completed ARTB questionnaire.

The President of USMRA will designate yearly a chairperson and committee to screen each packet. The committee will select the best packets according to criteria that they, the committee, develop in keeping with established criteria and the spirit and intent of the honor. The committee will prepare the selected packets with respect to form and content before submittal to 5th Rgr Tng Bn by 15 November. Announcement of award is made in February.
