

Fallen Ranger Memorial Nomination Procedure

March 3, 2022

The FRM candidate must meet the requirements for membership in the US Mountain Ranger Association. He must be a graduate of US Army Ranger School or have served with a designated Ranger unit during combat operations

A member of the USMRA must nominate the candidate.

The nominating member must complete a biography of the candidate that includes units served in, accomplishments, and remembrances. The bio can include but does not require the listing of all service school, awards and decorations. The bio may be edited for length in order to fit on a one-page document for presentation purposes.

The bio must be submitted in electronic format.

The nominating member must also include a separate photo of the honoree that is not included in the bio document.

The bio document and the photo must be emailed to Bob Williams at usmra.org@gmail.com.

The cut-off date for FRM submission is the February USMRA meeting. Candidates will be honored in the order received – six per year. Those not honored the current year will be moved to the following year. There is no penalty for early submission.

The nominating member must commit to be at the ceremony and be prepared to present the bio to those in attendance.

The nominating member is responsible for contacting and coordinating with family members.
